My first memory was when I came for my interview. I was very nervous but everyone was very welcoming. I couldn't wait to meet Bernard.


What is the best bit about working at St. Ambrose?

Year 2 loved learning about God's treasure in RE.




Year 3 loved learning about how to react in an emergency situation in PSHE this week
