EYFS have loved growing in confidence with their physical development.



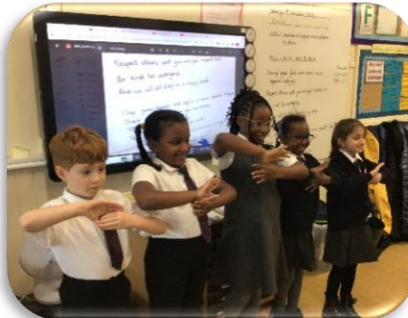
Year 1 loved thinking about 5 people they could tell if they were being bullied



Year 2 have loved using different joining techniques to design and make a freestanding structure.



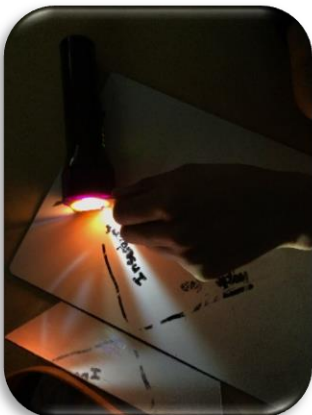
Year 3 have loved learning about reaching out to help and ask for help during Anti-Bullying Week!
