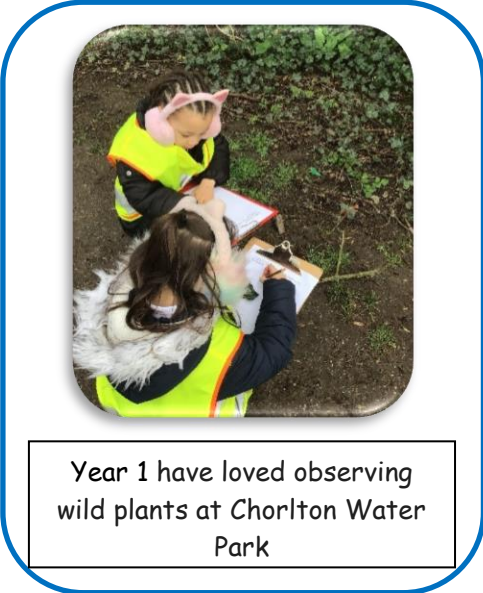


Loving Our Learning Journey

Spring 2 Week 4 of a great week at St. Ambrose and we are very proud of the learning that our children do.



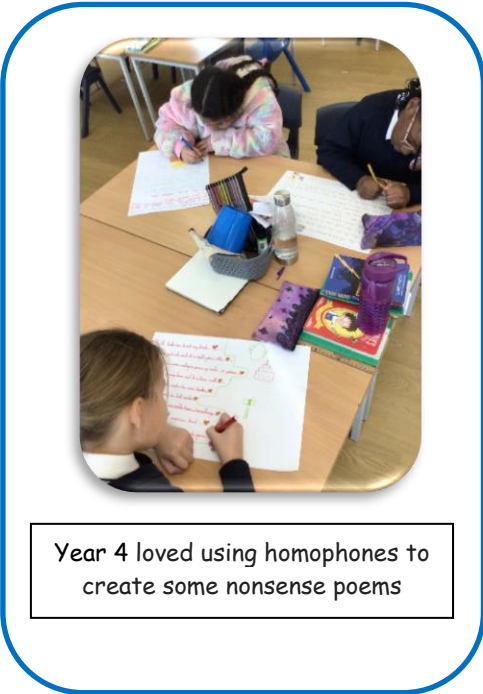
EYFS welcomed everyone to join a Stay and Play session
