It has been another wonderful week at St. Ambrose and we are proud of the children and their learning. You can see more pictures of their learning on our social media pages.



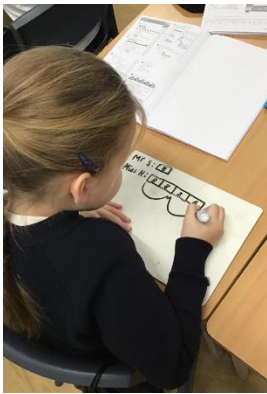
Early Years loved reading 'The Gruffalo' this week and have enjoyed practicing their cutting and sticking.
