Week 6 of a great week at St. Ambrose and we are very proud of the learning that our children do.



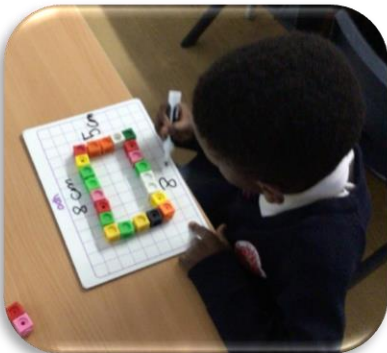
Early Years have loved making pancakes this week!
