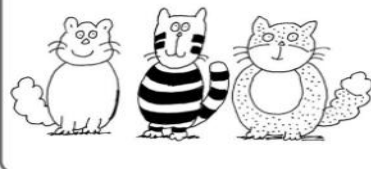
Maths Challenge
