We look forward to applying once again in 2020!

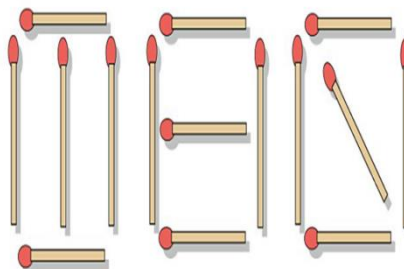

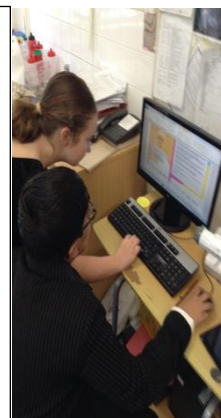
