Coronavirus update

Dear Parent/Guardian

You will be aware that the government has now increased their response to the outbreak of Coronovirus and as part of their delay plan, now ask that anyone with a fever of persistent cough self isolates for 7 days, irrespective of whether you have travelled or been in contact with someone known to have the virus.

If your child presents with any form of temperature above 37.8 degrees, develops or have a cough, we ask that you keep them home for 7 days.

If you or any family member presents with such symptoms, we ask that you inform us of your self-isolation and do not come to school any point during the self-isolation period.

In line with population distancing measures, we are postponing **all assemblies** until further notice, reducing the number of visitors as well as the following: Year 5 parent's drop in session – Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March

Ghyll Head Parents' meeting – Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March Parents' Evening – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April.

From today, these clubs will not happen: Yoga - Tuesday Rock band - Wednesday Stop-Motion Animation - Thursday Dance - Friday

Also, sports competitions against other schools and tournaments have been postponed until after Easter.

We will continue to promote good hand washing and hygiene routines with the children as put forward by Public Health England. We will also continue to update you, as and when, we receive further information.
