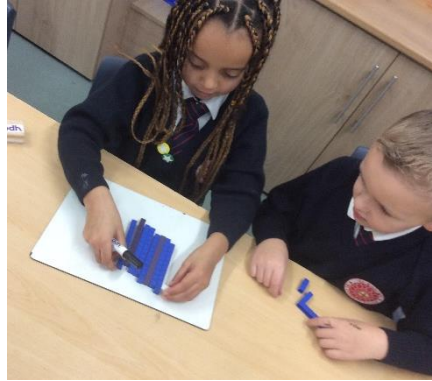


# Loving Our Learning

Early Years loved exploring different types of hats.



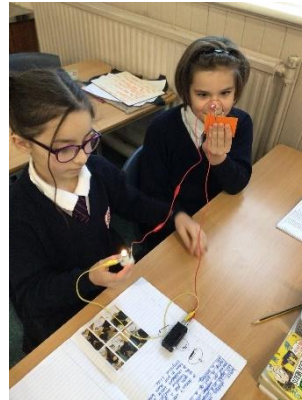
Year 1 loved using ten frames in maths.



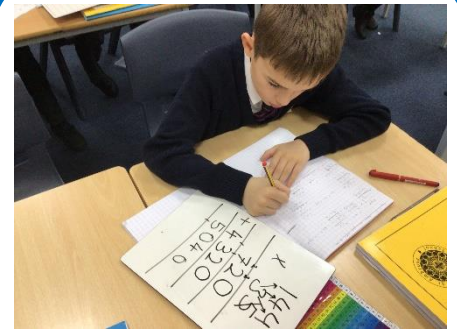
Year 2 loved learning about David and Goliath in RE



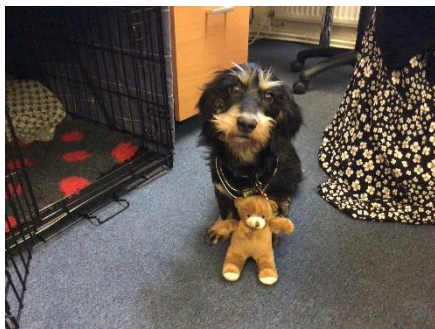
Year 3 loved learning how to use 'Scratch' in computing.
