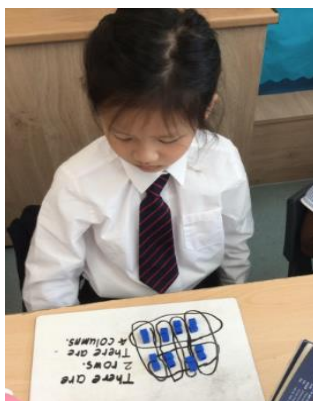


Loving Our Learning

Year 1 loved learning about arrays in maths.



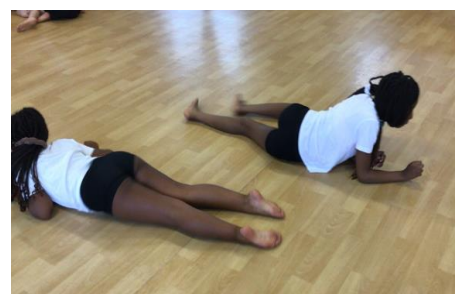
Y2 loved making pop art paintings of the Queen in art!
