#### Remote Learning for a Class Bubble

Dear Parents and Carers.

#### What is Remote Learning?

Learning will be set by the teacher and a daily video will be uploaded to the class website with instructions for the learning for that day. The children will have a bundle of books or activities from which their learning will be based on and the class teacher will inform you of the learning that should be completed each day.

In addition, activities will be set for children using internet platforms e.g. Numbots, Timetables Rockstars and Purple Mash. These are websites children use regularly and the passwords you will need have been stuck in your child's learning log. On request, these passwords can be sent electronically via the class email.
