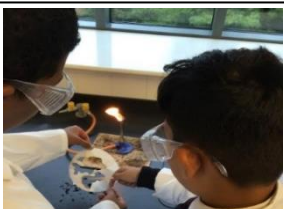

Early Years loved their weekly music lesson and have developed great skills with the musical instruments.



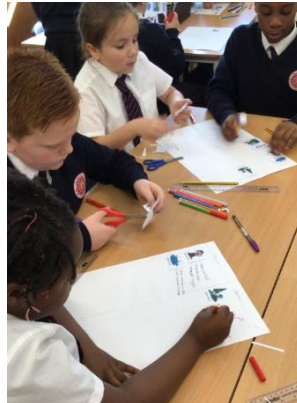
Year 1 loved reading the story 'Family and me' as part of their history topic.

Y4 loved learning about the positive and negative impacts humans have on the environment in science



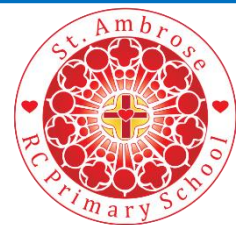
Year 5 loved planning how to make sarcophagus and creating them.
